Information about the **2023 Kansas Legislature** is only a phone call or chat away; the State Library of Kansas reminds residents. The toll-free number for the Legislative Hotline is **1-800-432-3924**. Calls are answered by experienced reference and research librarians at the State Library.

Frequently asked questions include:

- Who are my legislators?
- How can I contact them?
- What is the status of this bill?

Other questions may concern the legislative process, where to find historic information, and other Kansas government related questions.

The Hotline is open Monday-Friday from 8 am to 5 pm, however constituents can leave a brief message for their legislators, or for a librarian's response. Questions can also be emailed to [infodesk@ks.gov](mailto:infodesk@ks.gov).
